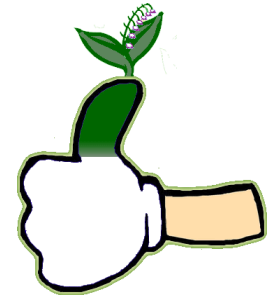




# South Hampton Roads' Master Gardeners' Spring 2022
